

New Delhi the 30th March, 2001

No. P-20018/2/2000-PP - Whereas Government of India vide resolution No. P-20012/29/97-PP dated 21.11.1997 had notified the details of phased programme of dismantling the administered pricing mechanism (APM). And whereas in terms of the aforesaid details, pricing of aviation turbine fuel (ATF) is to be de-regulated during the year 2000-01.


2. Now therefore, in pursuance of the above decision, Government have decided to de-control the pricing of ATF with effect from April 1, 2001.
