

Monthly Report on Natural gas production, availability and consumption - March, 2016

- 1. Highlights of the report for the month of March, 2016 are as follows:
 - Gross production for the month of March 2016 was 2539.65 MMSCM which was decrease by 10.52 % over the corresponding month of the previous year.
 - Total import of LNG for the month of March 2016 was 1958.19 MMSCM which was an increase of 58.31 % over the corresponding month of the previous year.
 - Total consumption for the month of March 2016 was 3920.96 MMSCM which was increase of approximately 13.50 % over the corresponding month of the previous year.
 - Total consumption by fertilizer, power, petrochemicals, sponge iron, refinery and other sectors for the month of March 2016 was 131.97 MMSCMD.

- 2.1 Domestic natural gas production was lower by 4.18 % for the current financial year 2015-16 in comparison to the corresponding previous year 2014-15.



ONGC

ONGC's natural gas production in March, 2016 was 1642.76 MMSCM, which was lower by 228.06 MMSCM (12.19%) as compared to the corresponding month of the previous year.

The reasons for shortfall in production were less production in Bassein field due to BPB shutdown for carrying out reconstruction activities under "Reconstruction of BPA & BPB Platforms" project. There was less production from new and marginal field in Mumbai High also.

The present tie in works for hooking of the well with G1 facilities in eastern offshore also contributed towards lower production as the tie in work is in progress for which both the subsea wells of G1 field are closed since 9th Mar'16. Closure of wells in Cauvery basin on account of less/ nil off-take by consumers (M/s TNEB) in Ramnad / Kovilkallapal area along with the less offtake by consumers in Rajasthan region was the reasons for lower production.

OIL

OlL's natural gas production in March, 2016 was 253.68 MMSCM which was higher by 21.61MMSCM (9.31%) as compared to the corresponding month of the previous year.

Private/JV fields

Natural gas production under Pvt./JV fields in March, 2016 had decreased to 643.21 MMSCM from 735.35 MMSCM (12.53%) in comparison to the corresponding month of the previous year. There was production fall in Krishna Godavari D6 block (KGD6), KG-OSN, M&S Tapti, Ravva and RJ-ON-6 fields. However there was also increase in production of Panna-Mukta, RJ-ON-90/1, Raniganj east and CB/OS2 fields compared to the corresponding month of the previous year.

3. Natural Gas net availability

Natural Gas producing companies use some quantity of gas for their own use as nternal consumption while some quantity of gas is flared as a part of technical requirement. After flare, loss and internal consumption, the net availability of gas for other value added products like fertilizer, petrochemicals, CGD, refinery etc. and for fuel was approximately 78.57% of the gross production.

- 3.1 Natural Gas net availability was lower by 5.50% for the current financial year 2015- 2016 in comparison to the corresponding previous year 2014-15.
- 3.2 The reason for lower availability was mainly due to lower production of natural gas by domestic gas producing companies i.e. ONGC, OIL and Pvt./JVs companies.

4. LNG imports

LNG is procured by Petronet LNG Ltd., GAIL (India) Ltd., Gujarat State Petroleum Corporation Ltd., Reliance Industries Ltd., Hazira LNG Pvt. Ltd. and Indian Oil Corporation Ltd.



- 4.1 Overall LNG imports increased by 2773.55 MMSCM in the current financial year 2016-16 which was 14.96 % higher as compared to the corresponding previous year 2014-15.
- 4.2 LNG import for the month of March, 2016 increased by 721.29 MMSCM (58.31%) in comparison to the corresponding month of the previous year.


