




# Monthly Report on Natural gas production, availability and consumption – September 2017

#### 1. Highlights of the report for the month of September 2017 are as follows:

- Gross production for the month of September 2017 was 2723.23 MMSCM which was an increase by 4.74% over the corresponding month of the previous year.
- Total import of LNG for the month of September 2017 was 2414.42 MMSCM which increased by 4.77% over the corresponding month of the previous year.
- Natural Gas Available for Sale for the month of September 2017 was 4598.52 MMSCM which was an increase of approximately 6.30 % over the corresponding month of the previous year.
- Total consumption by fertilizer, power, petrochemicals, sponge iron, refinery and other sectors for the month of September 2017 was 4577.91 MMSCM (152.60 MMSCMD).








#### 3. Domestic Natural Gas Net Production for Sale:


Natural Gas producing companies use some quantity of gas for their own use as internal consumption while some quantity of gas is flared as a part of technical requirement. After flare, loss and internal consumption by gas producing companies, the net production for sale of gas to other sectors like fertilizer, petrochemicals, CGD, refinery etc. and for fuel was approximately 80.20% of the gross production during September, 2017.






#### 4. LNG imports:


LNG was procured during the month by Petronet LNG Ltd., GAIL (India) Ltd., Gujarat State Petroleum Corporation Ltd., Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., Reliance Industries Ltd., Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd. and Torrent Power Ltd.




50.21% of the total LNG import in September, 2017 was from Qatar, 15.24% from Singapore, 13.67% from Nigeria, 7.45% from Australia, 6.47% from Equatorial Guinea and 3.63% from Malaysia and 3.33% from Oman.
