

1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

### **Highlights**


- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during May 2020 and April May 2020
  was lower by 7.1% and 6.7% respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the
  previous year.
- Crude oil processed in refineries during May 2020 was 16.3 MMT, which was 24.2% lower than May 2019. On cumulative basis total crude oil processed was 31.1 MMT which was lower by 26.5% during April – May 2020 as compared to April – May 2019.
- Production of petroleum products saw a de-growth of 21.3% and 22.7% respectively during May 2020 and April – May 2020 over the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports decreased by 22.6% and 19.2% during May 2020 and April May 2020 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports decreased by 0.8% and 3.6% during May 2020 and April May 2020 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Decrease in POL products imports during April May 2020 was due to decrease in imports of motor spirit (MS), aviation turbine fuel (ATF), high-speed diesel (HSD), LOBS/lube oil, bitumen and petcoke etc.
- Exports of POL products increased by 5.9% and 19.8% during May 2020 and April May 2020 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during April May 2020 was due to increase in exports of high-speed diesel (HSD), LOBS/lube oil, fuel oil and petcoke /CBFS etc.



#### 2. Indigenous crude oil and condensate production


• The percentage share of PSU upstream companies and PSC fields in overall crude oil and condensate production during April – May 2020 (P) is shown in figure-1 below:

Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April – May (P)



Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April-May<sup>(P)</sup>







Figure-4; Percentage share of indigenous and imported crude oil processed by Private refineries: April-May<sup>(P)</sup>








Figure-5; Product wise production of POL products by refineries and fractionators: April - May2020 (P)







Figure-6; Percentage share of POL products in production; April - May 2020<sup>(P)</sup>









- Crude oil imports decreased by 22.6% and 19.2% during May 2020 and April May 2020 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries decreased to 73.3% of total imports during
   April May 2020 as compared to 73.8% during April May 2019.



Import of LPG Imports made due to deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 47.4% share of total POL products import during April – May 2020 as compared to 38.1% during April – May 2019. Import of petcoke accounted for 26.3% of the total POL imports during April – May 2020. The entire quantity was imported by private importers and mainly by cement industry.




Figure 9: Percentage share of petroleum products in exports: April – May 2020<sup>(P)</sup>

Exports of POL products increased by 5.9% and 19.8% during May 2020 and April - May 2020 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
