
## **Petroleum Planning & Analysis Cell**

(Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas)

1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

### **Highlights**


- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during October 2020 and April October 2020 was lower by 6.2 % and 6.1% respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil processed in refineries during October 2020 was 18.4 MMT, which was 16.1 % lower than October 2019. On cumulative basis total crude oil processed was 118.6 MMT which was lower by 19.7 % during April October 2020 as compared to April October 2019.
- Production of petroleum products saw a de-growth of 17.0 % and 16.4 % respectively during October 2020 and April – October 2020 over the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports decreased by 21.6 % and 20.2 % during October 2020 and April October
   2020 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports decreased by 53.1% and 6.4% during October 2020 and April October 2020 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous
  year. Decrease in POL products imports during April October 2020 was due to decrease
  in imports of Motor Spirit (MS), Naphtha, High Speed Diesel (HSD), LOBS/ Lube Oil and
  Pet Coke.
- Exports of POL products decreased by 35.7% and 11% during October 2020 and April October 2020 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous
  year. Decrease in POL products exports during April October 2020 was due to decrease
  in exports of all major POL products except HSD and LOBS/Lube Oil.



#### 2. Indigenous crude oil and condensate production


• The percentage share of PSU upstream companies and PSC fields in overall crude oil and condensate production during April – October 2020 (P) is shown in figure-1 below:

Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April – October



Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April-October







Figure-4; Percentage share of indigenous and imported crude oil processed by Private refineries: April-October







Figure-5; Product wise production of POL products by refineries and fractionators: April – October 2020 (P)






Figure-6; Percentage share of POL products in production; April - October 2020 (P)



- Crude oil imports decreased by 21.6 % and 20.2% during October 2020 and April - October 2020 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries decreased to 77.1 % of total imports during April to October 2020 as compared to 78.7% during April to October 2019.



- Imports made due to deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 45.0% share of total POL products import during April October 2020 as compared to 41.0 % during April October 2019.
- Import of petcoke accounted for 24.9 % of the total POL imports during April October 2020. The entire quantity was imported by private importers and mainly by cement industry.


