

1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

Highlights


- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during April 2021 was lower by 2.1% as compared to April 2020.
- Crude oil processed in refineries during April 2021 was 19.9 MMT, which was 34.9% higher than April 2020.
- Production of petroleum products saw a growth of 30.9% during April 2021 over April 2020.
- Crude oil imports increased by 10.3% during April 2021 as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports increased by 24.2% as compared to the corresponding period of the
 previous year. Increase in POL products imports during April 2021 was due to increase in
 imports of all products except liquified petroleum gas (LPG) and high speed diesel (HSD).
- Exports of POL products decreased by 35.7% during April 2021 as compared to the
 corresponding period of the previous year. Decrease in POL products exports during April
 2021 was due to decrease in exports of high speed diesel (HSD), naphtha, aviation turbine
 fuel (ATF), fuel oil (FO) and petcoke/CBFS.



2. Indigenous crude oil and condensate production


 The percentage share of PSU upstream companies and PSC fields in overall crude oil and condensate production during April 2021^(P) is shown in figure-1 below:

Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April (P)



Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April (P)







Figure-4; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in private refineries in April(P)








Figure-6; Percentage share of POL products in production; April 2021 (P)






5.a Import of Crude oil

- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries increased to 79.1% of total imports during April 2021 as compared to 69.6% during April 2020.



- Imports made due to deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 35.7% share of total POL products import during April 2021 as compared to 53.9% during April 2020.
- Import of petcoke accounted for 24.4% of the total POL imports during April 2021.
 The entire quantity was imported by private importers and mainly by cement industry.


