

1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

Highlights


- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during June 2021 and April June 2021 was lower by 1.8 % and 3.4 % respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil processed during May 2021 was 18.4 MMT, which was 4.9 % higher than June 2020. On cumulative basis total crude oil processed was 57.3 MMT which was higher by 17.7 % during April – June 2021 as compared to April – June 2020.
- Production of petroleum products saw a growth of 2.4 % and 15.4 % during June 2021
 and April June 2021 respectively over the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports increased by 16.3% and 14.7% during June 2021 and April-June 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports increased by 3% and decreased by 3.2% during June 2021 and April-June 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
 Decrease in POL products imports during April-June 2021 was due to decrease in imports of petcoke, liquified petroleum gas (LPG), high speed diesel (HSD) and aviation turbine fuel (ATF).
- Exports of POL products increased by 24.9% and decreased by 6.4% during June 2021 and April-June 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
 Decrease in POL products exports during April-June 2021 (P) was due to decrease in exports of high speed diesel (HSD), petcoke/CBFS, naphtha, fuel oil (FO) and LOBS/Lube oil.



2. Indigenous crude oil and condensate production


• The percentage share of PSU upstream companies and PSC fields in overall crude oil and condensate production during April – June 2021 (P) is shown in figure-1 below:

Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April – June (P)



Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April-June^(P)







Figure-4; Percentage share of indigenous and imported crude oil processed by Private refineries: April-June^(P)








Figure-5; Product wise production of POL products by refineries and fractionators: April - June2021 (P)



Figure-5; Percentage share of products in total POL production: April - June 2021 (P)





- Crude oil imports increased by 16.3% and 14.7% during June 2021 and April-June 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries decreased to 69.7% of total imports during April to June 2021 as compared to 72.1% during April to June 2020.




Figure 8: Percentage share of petroleum products in imports: April to June 2021 (P)

- Imports made due to deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 40.5% share of total POL products import during April-June 2021 as compared to 42.3% during April-June 2020.
- Import of petcoke accounted for 25.2% of the total POL imports during April-June 2021. The entire quantity was imported by private importers and mainly by cement industry.


