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1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

Highlights


- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during October 2021 and April October 2021 was lower by 2.2 % and 2.8 % respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil processed during October 2021 was 21.0 MMT, which was 14.0 % higher than October 2020. On cumulative basis total crude oil processed was 134.24 MMT which was higher by 13.2 % during April – October 2021 as compared to April – October 2020.
- Production of petroleum products saw a growth of 14.4 % and 11.7 % during October 2021 and April – October 2021 respectively over the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports increased by 11.1% and 13.3% during October 2021 and April-October 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports increased by 28% and decreased by 1.2% during October 2021 and April-October 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Decrease in POL products imports during April-October 2021 was due to decrease in imports of petcoke, high speed diesel (HSD), superior kerosene oil (SKO) and aviation turbine fuel (ATF).
- Exports of POL products increased by 37.9% and 4.6% during October 2021 and April-October 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during April-October 2021 was due to increase in exports of all products except LOBS/Lube oil and petcoke/CBFS.


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2. Indigenous crude oil and condensate production




Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April – October





Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April-October





Figure-6; Percentage share of products in total POL production: April – October 2021^(P)

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

- Crude oil imports increased by 11.1% and 13.3% during October 2021 and April-October 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries decreased to 69.8% of total imports during April-October 2021 as compared to 75.1% during April- October 2020.




Figure 8: Percentage share of petroleum products in imports: April to October 2021 (P)

- Imports made due to deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 48.5% share of total POL products import during April-October 2021 as compared to 44.3% during April-October 2020.
- Import of petcoke accounted for 11.1% of the total POL imports during April-October 2021. The entire quantity was imported by private importers and mainly by cement industry.




Figure 9: Percentage share of petroleum products in export: April to October 2021 (P)
