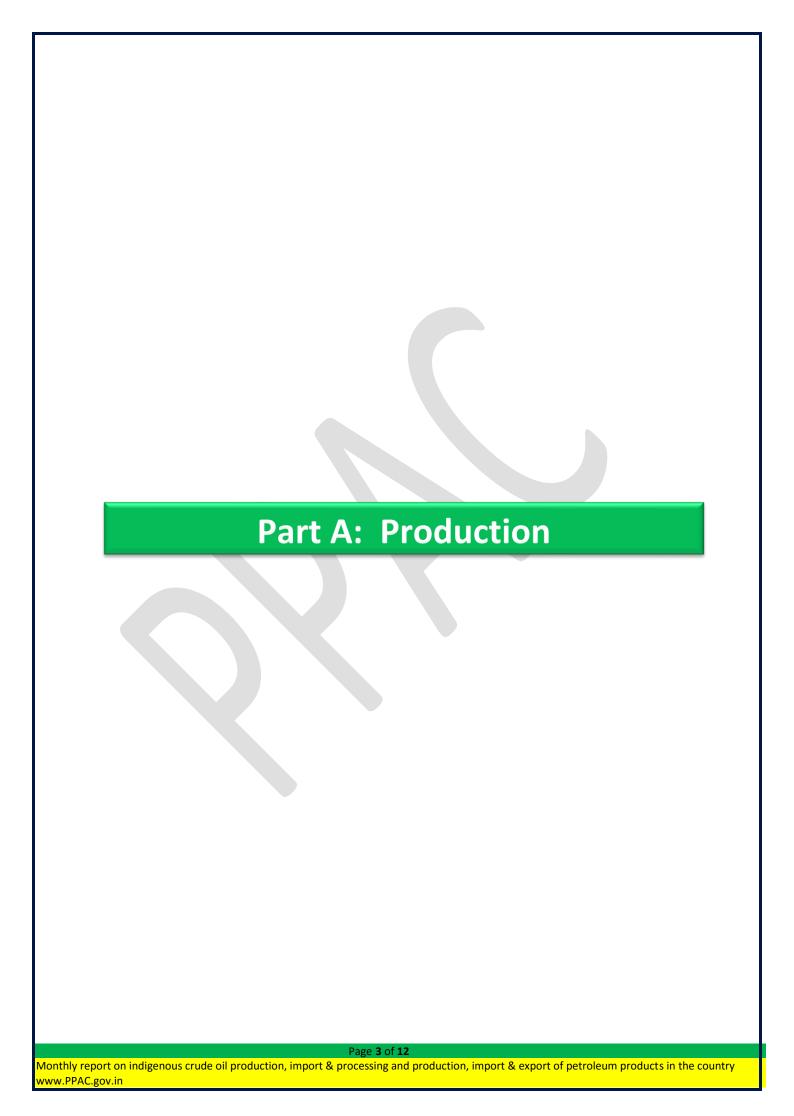

1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

### **Highlights**

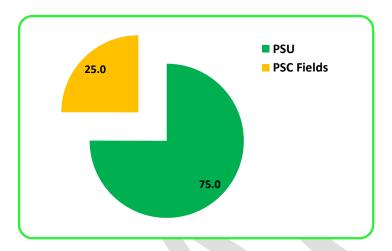
- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during September 2021 and April –
   September 2021 was lower by 1.7 % and 2.9 % respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil processed during September 2021 was 18.2 MMT, which was 2.9% higher than September 2020. On cumulative basis total crude oil processed was 113.29 MMT which was higher by 13.1 % during April – September 2021 as compared to April – September 2020.
- Production of petroleum products saw a growth of 6.0 % and 11.2 % during
   September 2021 and April September 2021 respectively over the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports increased by 16% and 13.1% during September 2021 and April-September
   2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports increased by 13% and decreased by 6.2% during September 2021 and
  April-September 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous
  year. Decrease in POL products imports during April-September 2021 was due to decrease
  in imports of petcoke, high speed diesel (HSD), superior kerosene oil (SKO) and aviation
  turbine fuel (ATF).
- Exports of POL products increased by 3% and 0.3% during September 2021 and April-September 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during April-September 2021 (P) was due to increase in exports of aviation turbine fuel (ATF), fuel oil (FO), motor sprit (MS), naphtha, liquified petroleum gas (LPG), superior kerosene oil (SKO) and bitumen.



#### 2. Indigenous crude oil and condensate production

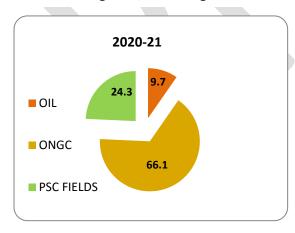
• The percentage share of PSU upstream companies and PSC fields in overall crude oil and condensate production during April – September 2021 (P) is shown in figure-1 below:

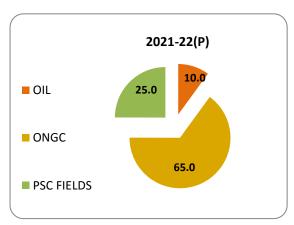
Figure-1; Percentage share in crude oil and condensate production; April – September 2021 (P)

Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April – September



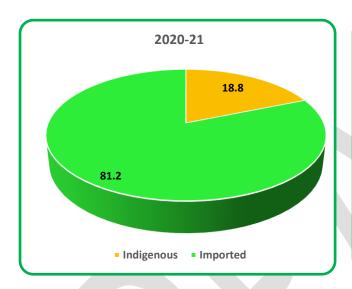

Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April-September



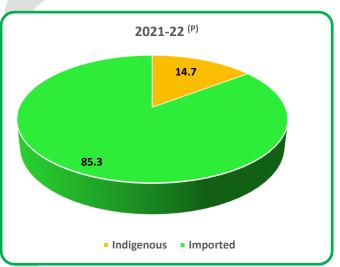
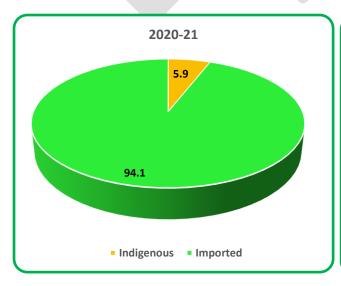


Figure-4; Percentage share of indigenous and imported crude oil processed by Private refineries: April-September



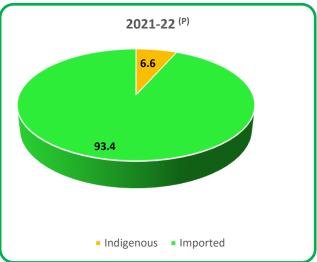

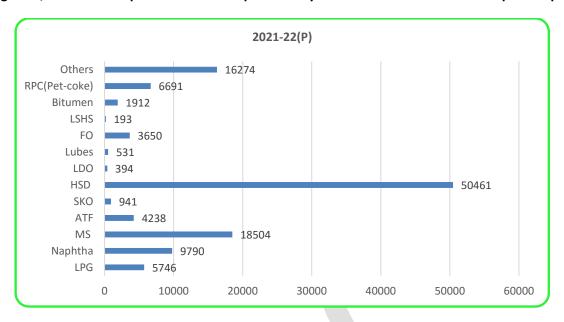

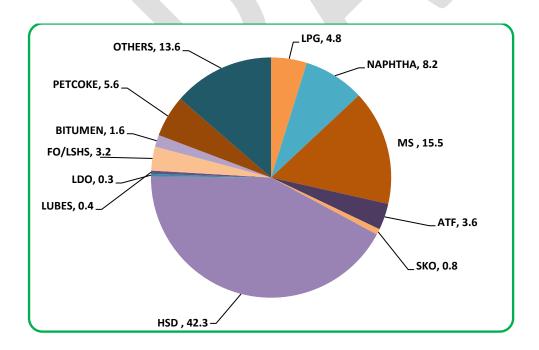

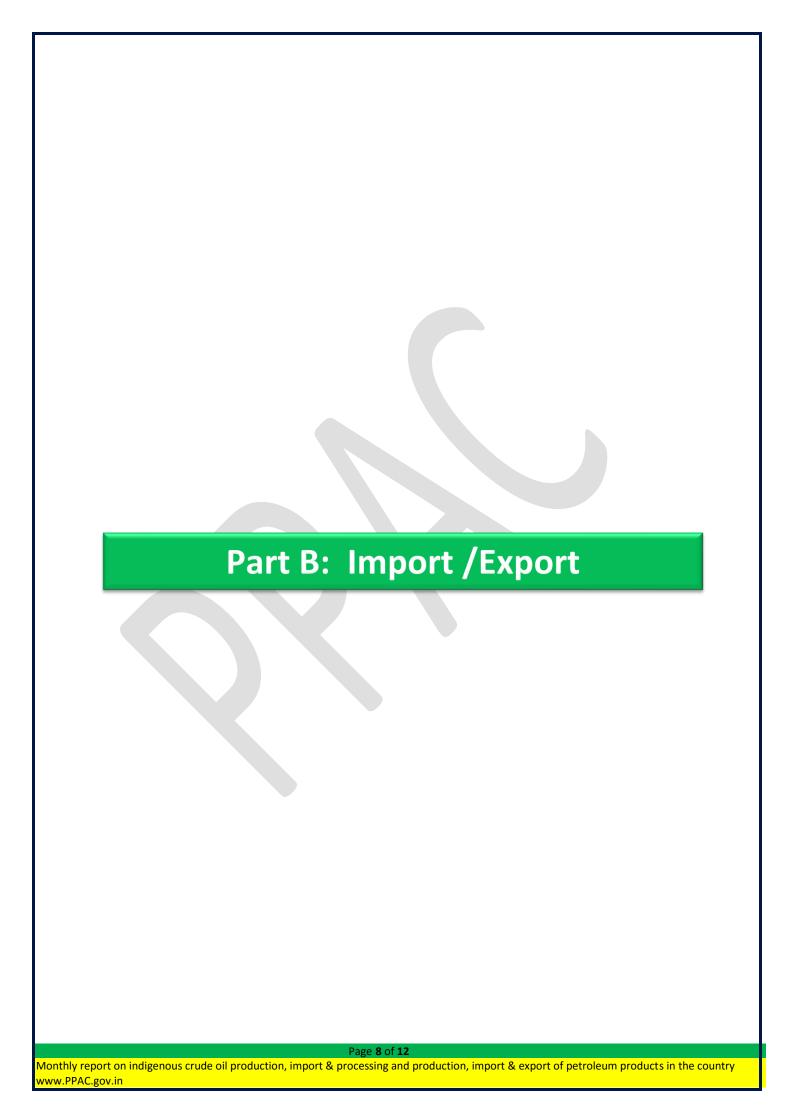
Figure-5; Product wise production of POL products by refineries and fractionators: April – September 2021 (P)

Figure-6; Percentage share of products in total POL production: April – September 2021 (P)



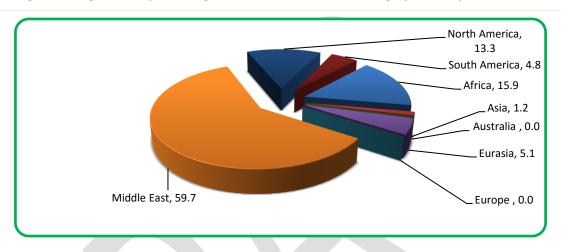

- Crude oil imports increased by 16% and 13.1% during September 2021 and April-September 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries decreased to 69.7% of total imports during April-September 2021 as compared to 73.9% during April- September 2020.

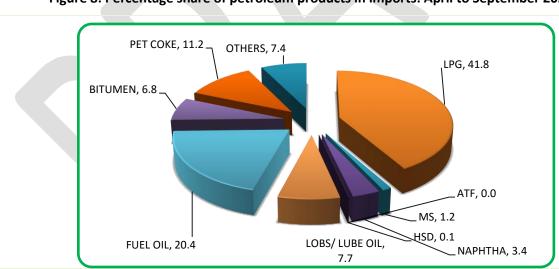


Figure 8: Percentage share of petroleum products in imports: April to September 2021 (P)

- Imports made due to deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 49.4% share of total POL products import during April-September 2021 as compared to 42.9% during April-September 2020.
- Import of petcoke accounted for 11.2% of the total POL imports during April-September 2021. The entire quantity was imported by private importers and mainly by cement industry.

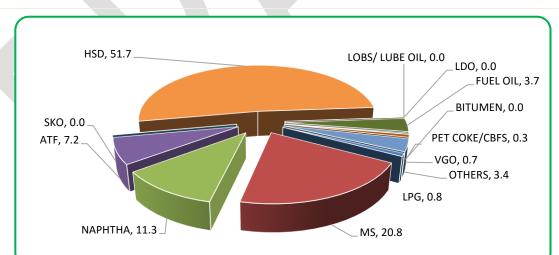


Figure 9: Percentage share of petroleum products in export: April to September 2021 (P)

 Exports of POL products increased by 3% and 0.3% during September 2021 and April-September 2021 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during April-September 2021 (P) was due to increase in exports of aviation turbine fuel (ATF), fuel oil (FO), motor sprit (MS), naphtha, liquified petroleum gas (LPG), superior kerosene oil (SKO) and bitumen.
