

1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

# **Highlights**


- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during December 2023 was 2.5 MMT. OIL
  registered a production of 0.3 MMT, ONGC registered a production of 1.6 MMT whereas
  PSC/RSC registered production of 0.6 MMT during December 2023.
- Total Crude oil processed during December 2023 was 22.7 MMT which is 1.9% higher than December 2022, where PSU/JV refiners processed 15.7 MMT and private refiners processed 7.0 MMT of crude oil. Total indigenous crude oil processed was 2.6 MMT and total Imported crude oil processed was 20.1 MMT by all Indian refineries (PSU+JV+PVT). There was a growth of 3.3 % in total crude oil processed in April-December FY 2023 24 as compared to same period of FY 2022 23.
- Production of petroleum products was 24.5 MMT during December 2023 which is 4.0% higher than December 2022. Out of 24.5 MMT, 24.2 MMT was from refinery production & 0.3 MMT was from fractionator. There was a growth of 4.9 % in production of petroleum products in April-December FY 2023 24 as compared to same period of FY 2022 23. Out of total POL production, in December 2023, share of HSD is 41.7 %, MS 17.4 %, Naphtha 6.1 %, ATF 6.1 %, Pet Coke 5.5 %, LPG 4.8% which are of major products and rest are shared by Bitumen, FO/LSHS, LDO, Lubes & others.
- Crude oil imports increased by 1.1% and 0.4% during December 2023 and April-December 2023 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports decreased by 4.1% and increased by 9.9% during December 2023 and April-December 2023 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL product imports during April-December 2023 were mainly due to an increase in imports of petcoke, bitumen and fuel oil (FO).
- Exports of POL products increased by 2.5% and 2.7% during December 2023 and April-December 2023 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
   Increase in POL products exports during April-December 2023 were mainly due to increase in exports of aviation turbine fuel (ATF), motor-spirit (MS) and vacuum gas oil (VGO).


• The percentage share of PSU upstream companies and PSC fields in overall crude oil and condensate production during April-December 2023 (P) is shown in figure-1 below:


Figure-1; Percentage share in crude oil and condensate production; April – December 2023 (P)

Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April - December





Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April - December








Figure-4; Percentage share of indigenous and imported crude oil processed by Private refineries: April -December



Figure-5; Product wise production of POL products by refineries and fractionators: April-December 2023 (P)






Figure-6; Percentage share of products in total POL production: April-December 2023 (P)





- Crude oil imports increased by 1.1% and 0.4% during December 2023 and April-December 2023 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries decreased to 48.6% of total imports during
   April-December 2023-24 as compared to 61.8% during April-December 2022-23.




Figure 8: Percentage share of petroleum products in imports: April to December 2023-24 (P)

- Imports made due to deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 42.4% share of total POL products import during April-December 2023-24 as compared to 46.5% during April-December 2022-23.
- Import of petcoke accounted for 20.9% of the total POL imports during April-December 2023-24. The entire quantity was imported by private importers.




Figure 9: Percentage share of petroleum products in export: April to December 2023-24 (P)

Exports of POL products increased by 2.5% and 2.7% during December 2023 and April-December 2023 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during April-December 2023 were mainly due to increase in exports of aviation turbine fuel (ATF), motor-spirit (MS) and vacuum gas oil (VGO).
