

1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

Highlights


- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during April 2024 was 2.4 MMT. OIL
 registered a production of 0.3 MMT, ONGC registered a production of 1.6 MMT whereas
 PSC registered production of 0.5 MMT during April 2024. There is a growth of 1.6% in crude
 oil and condensate production during April 2024 as compared to April 2023.
- Total Crude oil processed during April 2024 was 21.6 MMT which is 0.8% higher than April 2023, where PSU/JV refiners processed 14.5 MMT and private refiners processed 7.1 MMT of crude oil. Total indigenous crude oil processed was 2.2 MMT and total Imported crude oil processed was 19.4 by all Indian refineries (PSU+JV+PVT).
- Production of petroleum products was 23.4 MMT during April 2024 which is 3.9% higher than April 2023. Out of 23.4 MMT, 23.1 MMT was from refinery production & 0.3 MMT was from fractionator. Out of total POL production, in April 2024, share of HSD is 42.0 %, MS 15.7 %, Naphtha 6.7 %, ATF 6.6 %, Pet Coke 5.2 %, LPG 4.4% which are of major products and rest are shared by Bitumen, FO/LSHS, LDO, Lubes & others.
- Crude oil imports increased by 7.0% during April 2024 as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports increased by 35.3% during April 2024 as compared to the
 corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products imports during April
 2024 were mainly due to decrease in imports of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG), petcoke
 etc.
- Exports of POL products increased by 9.6% in April 2024 as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during April 2024 were mainly due to decrease in exports of fuel oil (FO), naphtha and high-speed diesel (HSD) etc.



2. Indigenous crude oil and condensate production


• The percentage share of PSU upstream companies and PSC fields in overall crude oil and condensate production during April 2024 (P) is shown in figure-1 below:


Figure-1; Percentage share in crude oil and condensate production; April 2024 (P)

Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April





Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April







Figure-4; Percentage share of indigenous and imported crude oil processed by Private refineries: April








Figure-5; Product wise production of POL products by refineries and fractionators: April 2024 (P)



The percentage share of various products in total POL production during April 2024 is shown below:







- Crude oil imports increased by 7.0% during April 2024 as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries increased to 53.2% of total imports during April 2024 as compared to 48.1% during April 2023.



- Imports made due to deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 47.2% share of total POL products import during April 2024 as compared to 43.9% during April 2023.
- Import of petcoke accounted for 20.9% of the total POL imports during April 2024.
 The entire quantity was imported by private importers.




Figure 9: Percentage share of petroleum products in export: April 2024 (P)

Exports of POL products increased by 9.6% in April 2024 as compared to the
corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during
April 2024 were mainly due to decrease in exports of fuel oil (FO), naphtha and highspeed diesel (HSD) etc.
