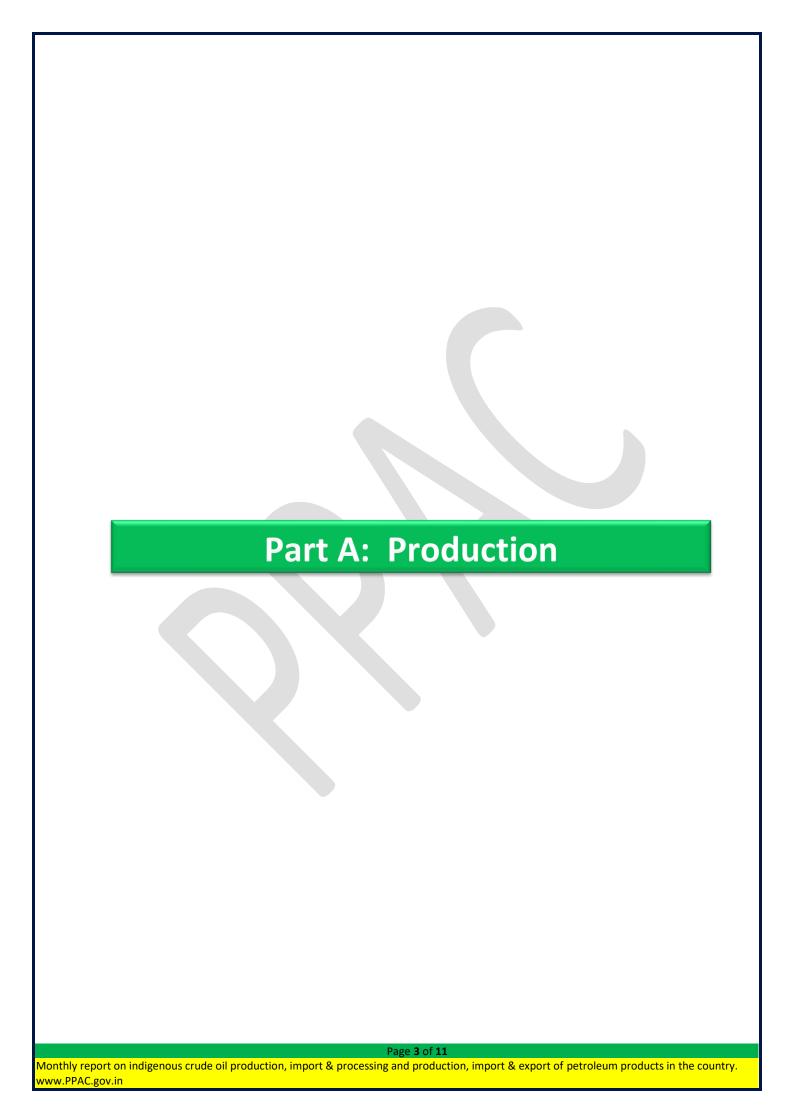

1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

Highlights

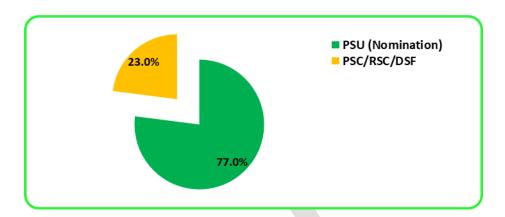
- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during October 2024 was 2.3 MMT. OIL
 registered a production of 0.3 MMT, ONGC registered a production of 1.6 MMT whereas PSC/RSC
 registered production of 0.5 MMT during October 2024. There is a de-growth of 4% in crude oil
 and condensate production during October 2024 as compared with the corresponding period of
 the previous year.
- Total Crude oil processed during October 2024 was 21.3 MMT which is 4.4 % higher than October 2023, where PSU/JV refiners processed 14 MMT and private refiners processed 7.3 MMT of crude oil. Total indigenous crude oil processed was 2.1 MMT and total imported crude oil processed was 19.2 MMT by all Indian refineries (PSU+JV+PVT). However, there was a growth of 1.8 % in total crude oil processed in April-October FY 2024 25 as compared to same period of FY 2023 24.
- Production of petroleum products was 23 MMT during October 2024, which is 5.3 % higher than October 2023. Out of 23 MMT, 22.7 MMT was from refinery production & 0.3 MMT was from fractionator. Out of total POL production, in October 2024, share of major products including HSD is 41.0 %, MS 16.8 %, Naphtha 6.8 %, ATF 6.6 %, Pet Coke 5.3 %, LPG 4.5%, and rest is shared by Bitumen, FO/LSHS, LDO, Lubes & others.
- Crude oil imports increased by 4.2% and 3.5% during October 2024 and April-October FY 2024-25
 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports decreased by 2.2% and increased by 7.7% during October 2024 and April-October FY 2024-25 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
 Increase in POL products imports during April-October FY 2024-25 were mainly due to increase in imports of petcoke, liquified petroleum gas (LPG) and lubes/LOBS etc.
- Exports of POL products increased by 12.7% and 4.2% during October 2024 and April-October FY 2024-25 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during April-October FY 2024-25 were mainly on account of increase in exports of petcoke/CBFS, fuel oil (FO), motor spirit (MS) and aviation turbine fuel (ATF) etc.



2. Indigenous crude oil and condensate production

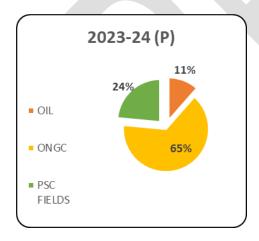

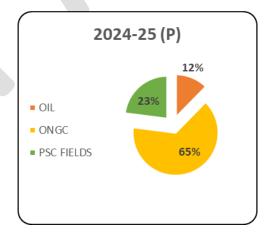
Figure-1; Percentage share in crude oil and condensate production; April-October FY 2024-25 (P)

Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April – October



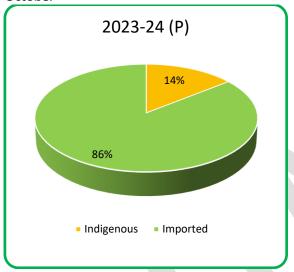

Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April - October



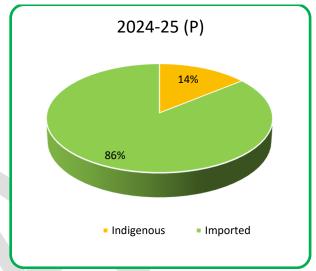
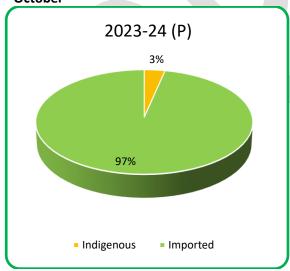
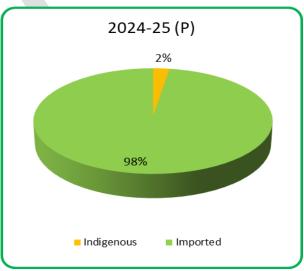


Figure-4; Percentage share of indigenous and imported crude oil processed by Private refineries: April - October

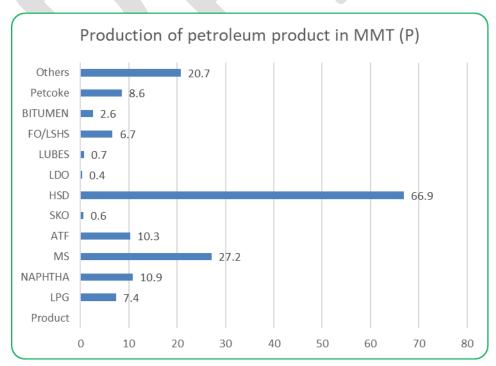

Figure-5; Product wise production of POL products by refineries and fractionators: April-October FY 2024-25 (P)

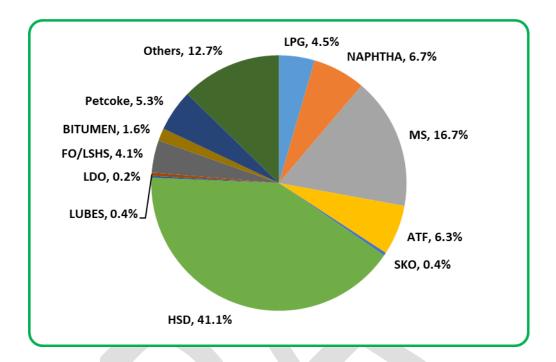


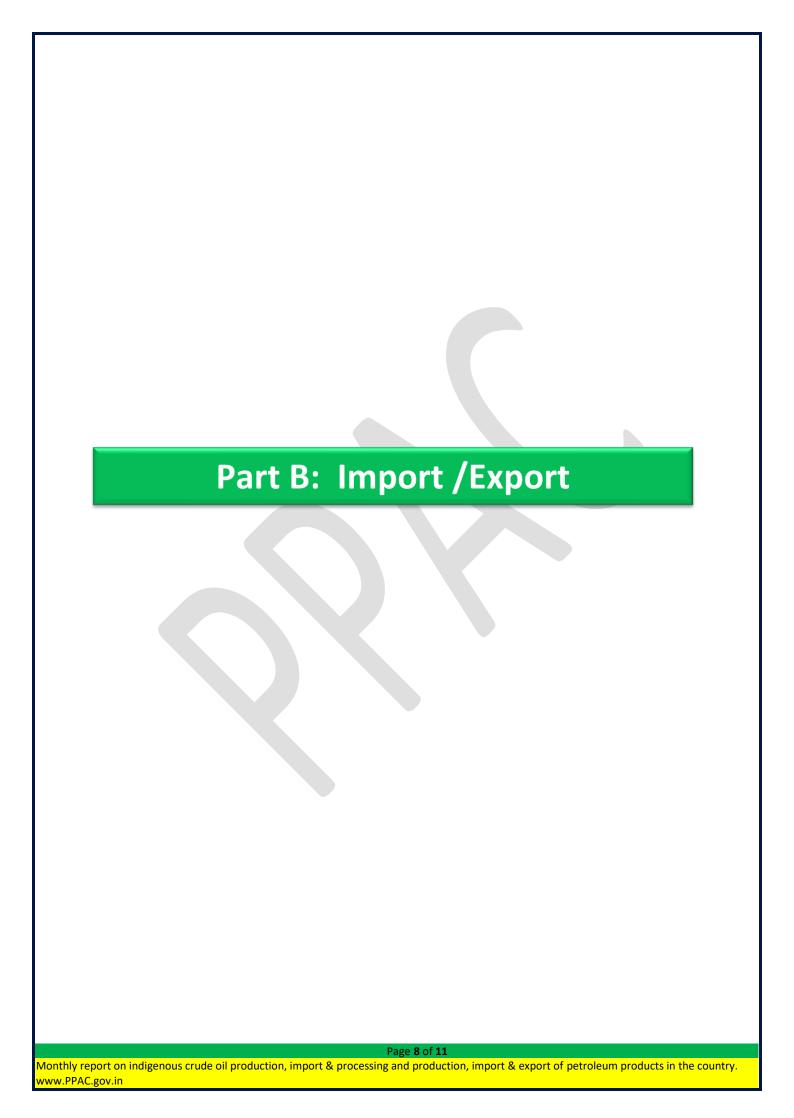

Figure-6; Percentage share of products in total POL production: April-October 2024-25 (P)



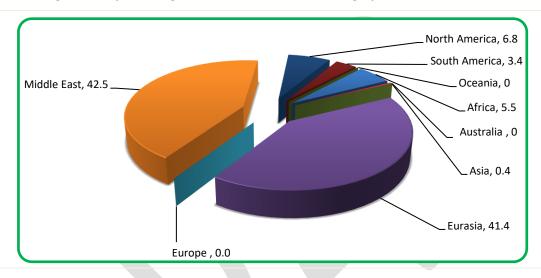

- Crude oil imports increased by 4.2% and 3.5% during October 2024 and April-October FY 2024-25 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries increased to 48.2% of total imports during April- October FY 2024-25 as compared to 47.6% during April- October FY 2023-24.

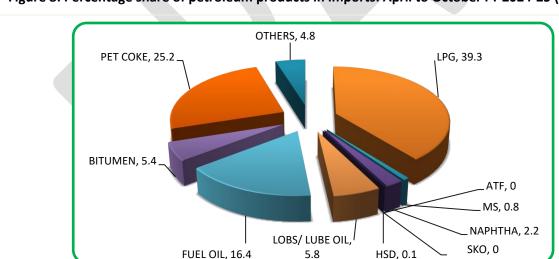


Figure 8: Percentage share of petroleum products in imports: April to October FY 2024-25 (P)

- Imports made due to deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 45.2% share of total POL products import during April- October FY 2024-25 as compared to 41.7% during April- October FY 2023-24.
- Imports of petcoke accounted for 25.2% of the total POL imports during April-October FY 2024-25. The entire quantity was imported by private importers.

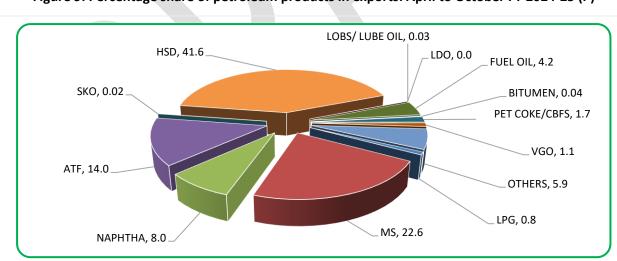


Figure 9: Percentage share of petroleum products in exports: April to October FY 2024-25 (P)

Exports of POL products increased by 12.7% and 4.2% during October 2024 and April-October FY 2024-25 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during April-October FY 2024-25 were mainly on account of increase in exports of petcoke/CBFS, fuel oil (FO), motor spirit (MS) and aviation turbine fuel (ATF) etc.
