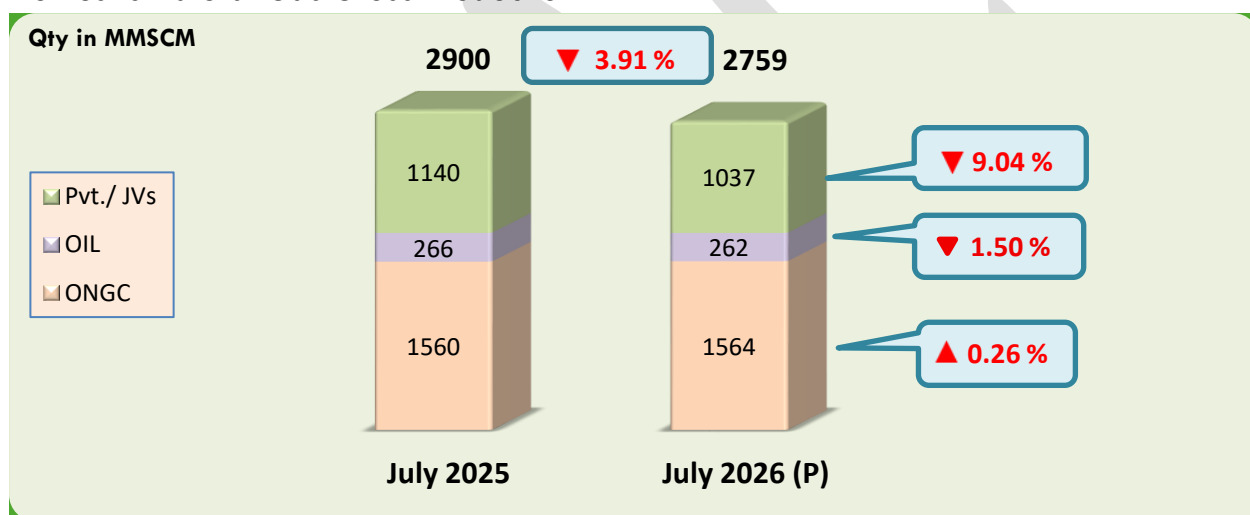

Monthly Report on Natural gas production, availability and consumption – July 2026

1. Highlights of the report for the month of July 2026 are as follows:

- Gross Production of natural gas for the month of July 2026 (P) was 2864 MMSCM which was lower by 3.48% compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.
- Total Import of LNG (Provisional) during the month of July 2026 (P) was 2915 MMSCM as per prorated DGCIS data.
- Natural Gas available for Sale during July 2026 (P) was 5287 MMSCM (P) (marginal decrease of 1.30% over the corresponding month of the previous year) and Total Gas Consumption Availability during July 2026 (P) was 5720 MMSCM (P) (marginal decrease of 1.05% over the corresponding month of the previous year).
- Major consumers were City Gas Distribution (CGD) (29.57%), Fertilizer (29.47%), Power (10.12%), Refinery (8.01%) and Petrochemicals (4.76%).

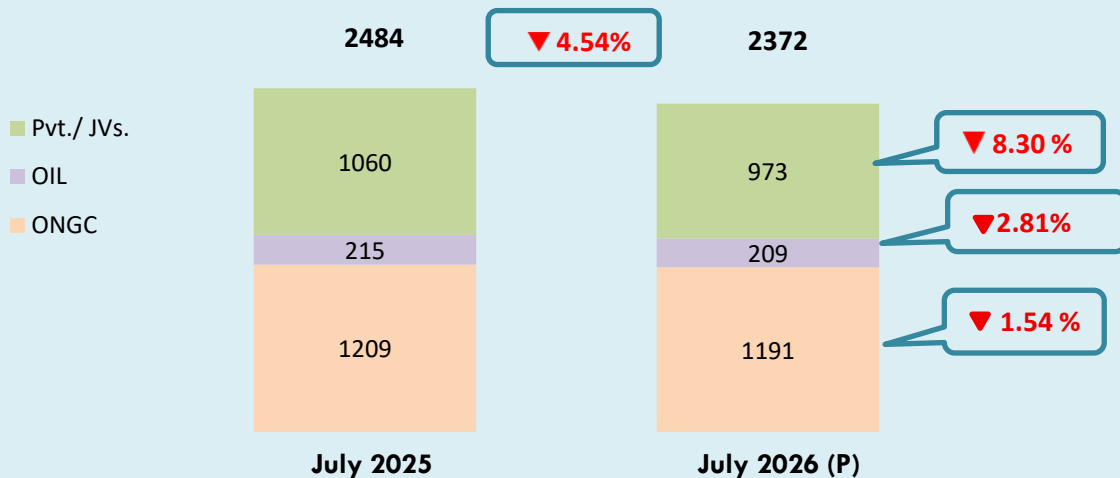


3. Domestic Natural Gas Net Production for Sale:

Natural Gas producing companies use some quantity of gas for their own use as internal consumption while some quantity of gas is flared as a part of technical requirement. After flare, loss and internal consumption by gas producing companies, the net production for sale of gas to consuming sectors like power, fertilizer, CGD, refinery, petrochemicals etc. was approximately 83% of the gross production during July 2026.

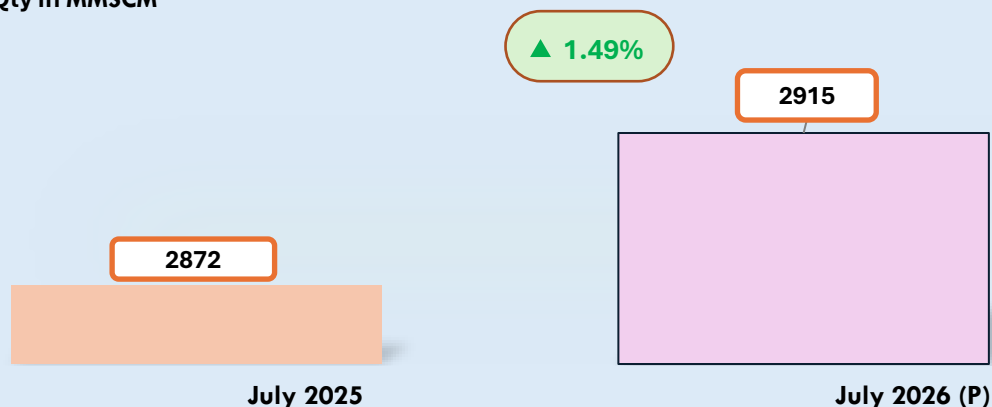
Qty in MMSCM

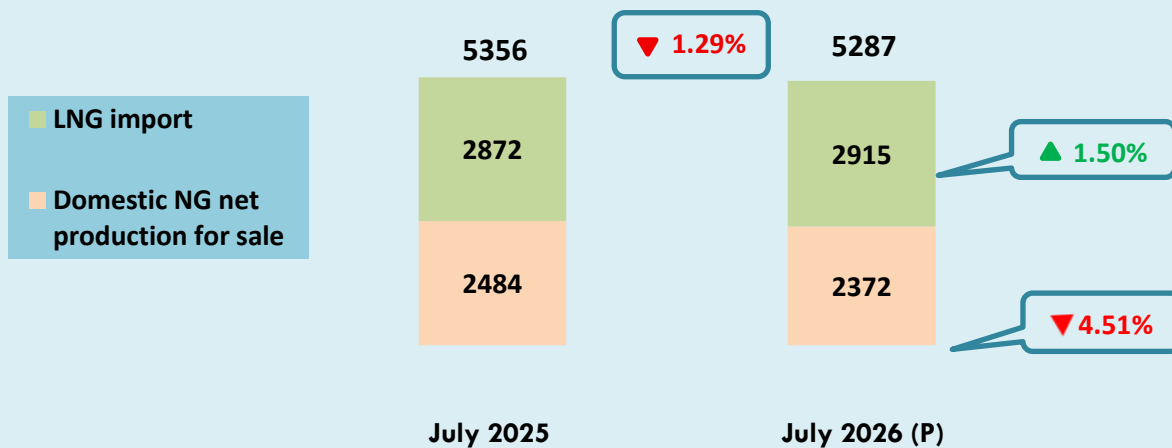

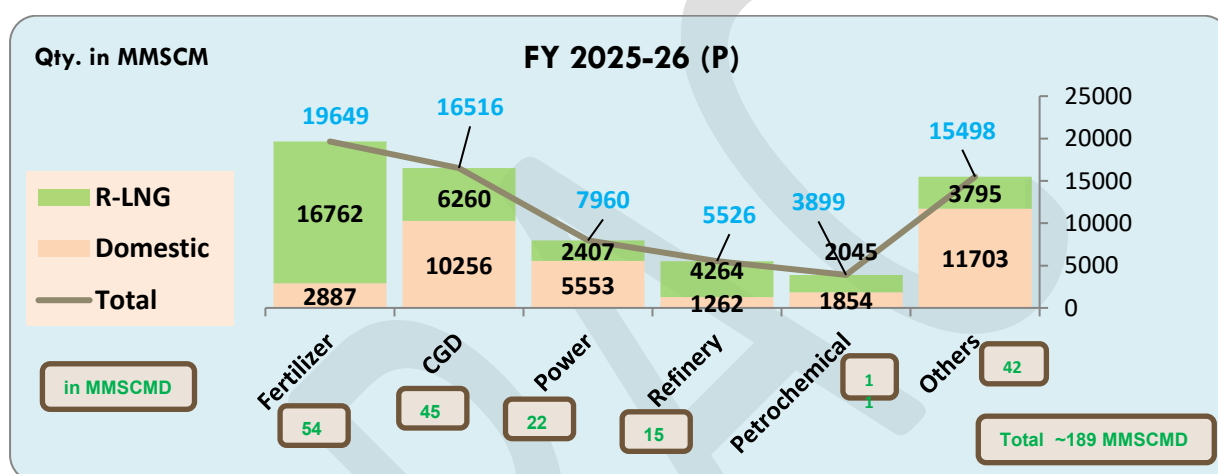
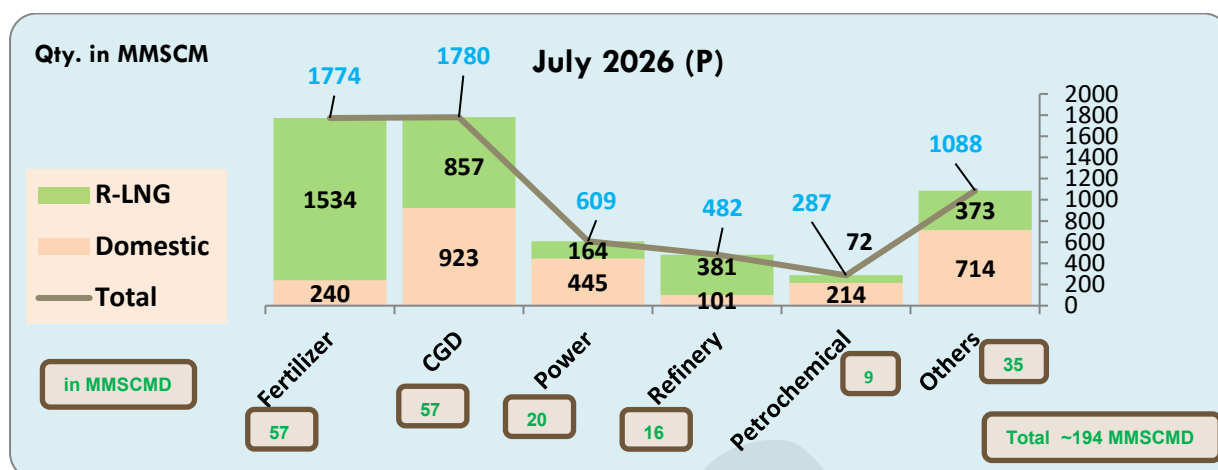
5. Total Natural Gas Available for Sale:
