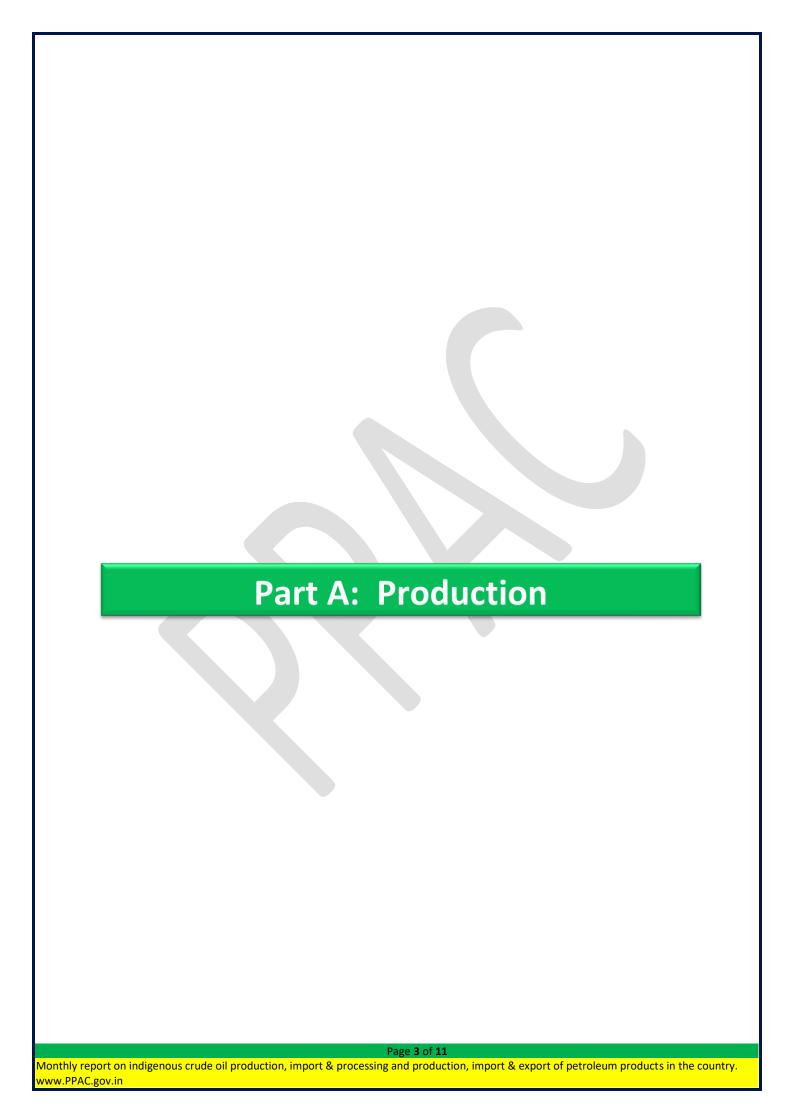

1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

Highlights

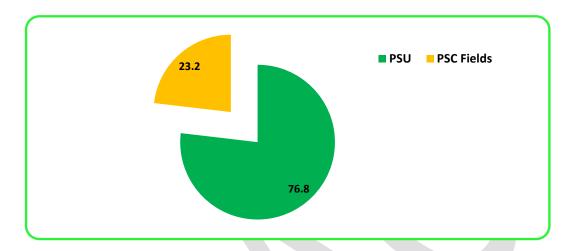
- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during September 2023 was 2.38 MMT.
 OIL registered a production of 0.27 MMT, ONGC registered a production of 1.55 MMT whereas PSC registered production of 0.56 MMT during September 2023.
- Total Crude oil processed during September 2023 was 20.3 MMT which is 3.8% higher than September 2022. Where PSU/JV Refiners processed 13.8 MMT and PVT Refiners Processed 6.5 MMT of Crude Oil. Total Indigenous Crude Oil processed was 2.4 MMT and total Imported Crude oil processed was 17.9 by all Indian Refineries (PSU+JV+PVT). There was a growth of 2.8 % in Total Crude oil processed in April September FY 2023 24 as compared to same period of FY 2022 23.
- Production of petroleum products was 21.5 MMT during September 2023 which is 5.5% higher than September 2022. Out of 21.5 MMT, 21.2 MMT was from Refinery production & 0.3 MMT was from Fractionator. There was a growth of 4.0 % in Production of petroleum products in April September FY 2023 24 as compared to same period of FY 2022 23. Out of total POL production, in September 2023, share of HSD is 41.6 %, MS 16.6 %, Naphtha 6.4 %, ATF 6.0 %, Pet Coke 5.4, %, LPG 4.1 % which are of major products and rest are shared by Bitumen, FO/LSHS, LDO, Lubes & others.
- Crude oil imports increased by 3.9% and 0.1% during September 2023 and April-September 2023 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports increased by 27.1% and 10.4% during September 2023 and April-September 2023 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. The rise in imports of POL products from April to September 2023 was primarily driven by increased imports of petcoke, bitumen and fuel oil.
- Exports of POL products decreased by 3.6% and 2.7% during September 2023 and April-September 2023 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. The decline in exports of POL products from April to September 2023 can be attributed primarily to reduced exports of high-speed diesel (HSD) and naphtha.

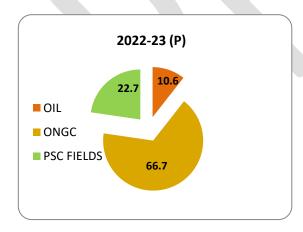

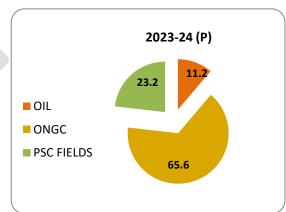
Figure-1; Percentage share in crude oil and condensate production; April – September 2023 (P)

Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April - September



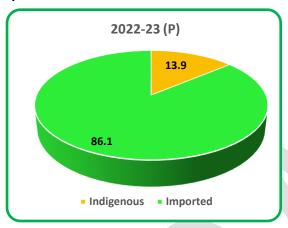

Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April - September



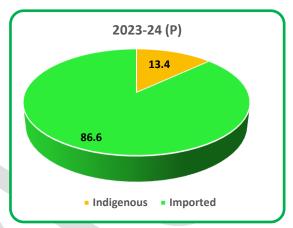
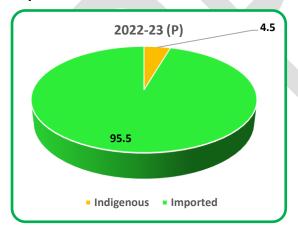
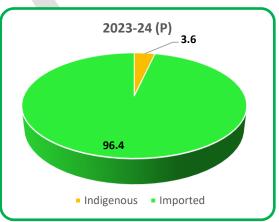


Figure-4; Percentage share of indigenous and imported crude oil processed by Private refineries: April - September

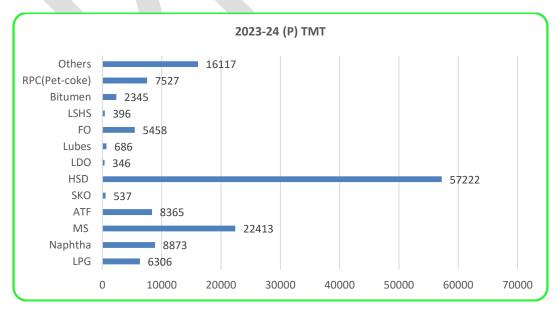

Figure-5; Product wise production of POL products by refineries and fractionators: April September 2023 (P)

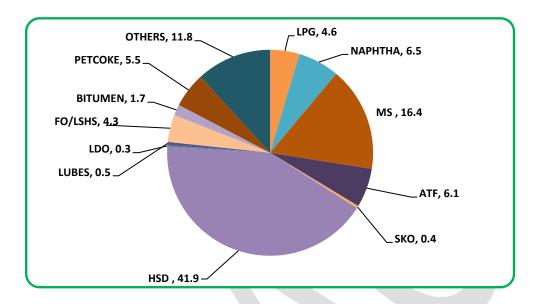

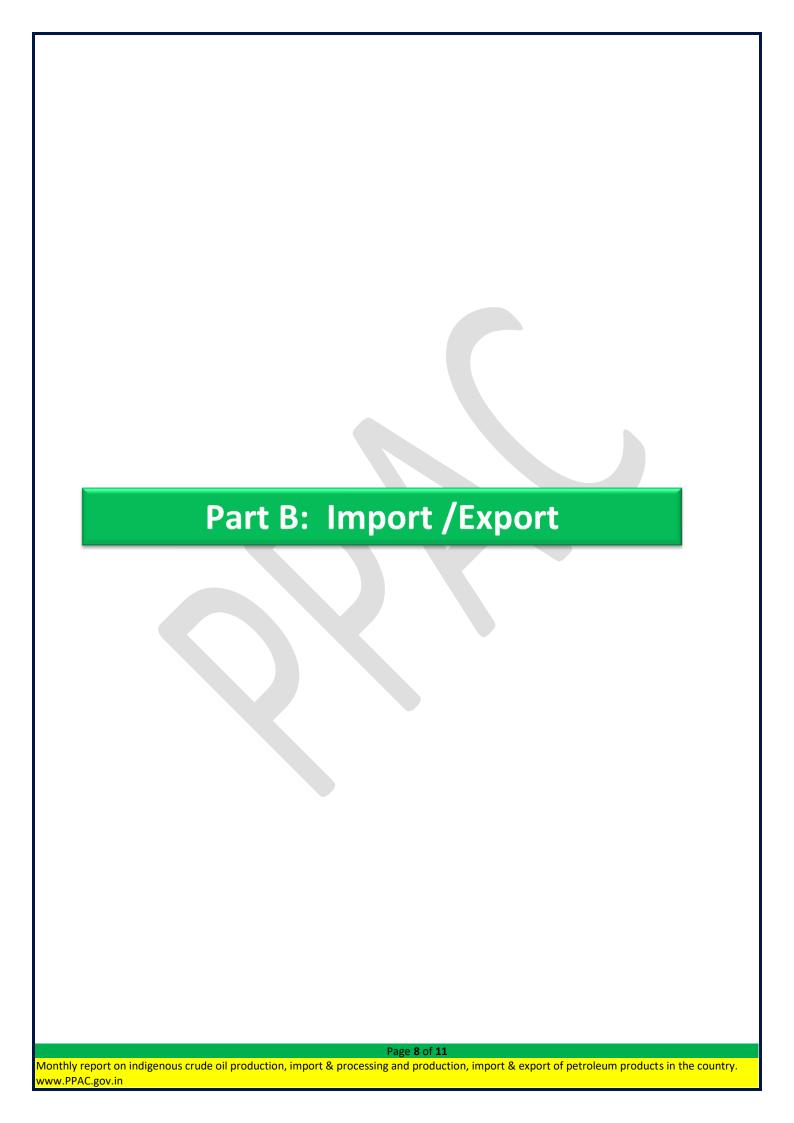

Figure-6; Percentage share of products in total POL production: April September 2023 (P)





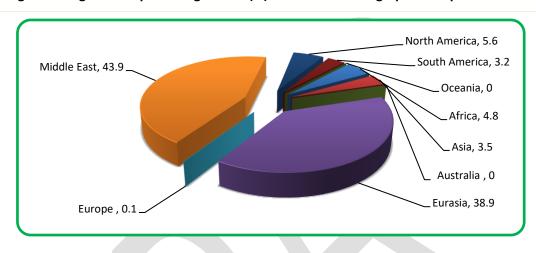

- Crude oil imports increased by 3.9% and 0.1% during September 2023 and April-September 2023 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries decreased to 47.3% of total imports during April-September 2023-24 as compared to 63.1% during April-September 2022-23.

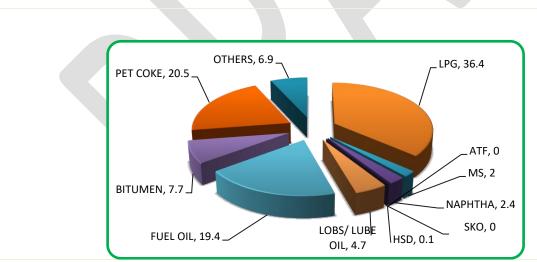


Figure 8: Percentage share of petroleum products in imports: April to September 2023-24 (P)

- Imports made due to deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 41% share of total POL products import during April-September 2023-24 as compared to 47.4% during April- September 2022-23.
- Import of petcoke accounted for 20.5% of the total POL imports during April-September 2023-24. The entire quantity was imported by private importers.

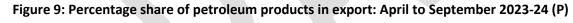

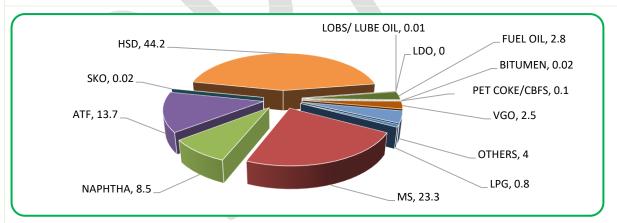
