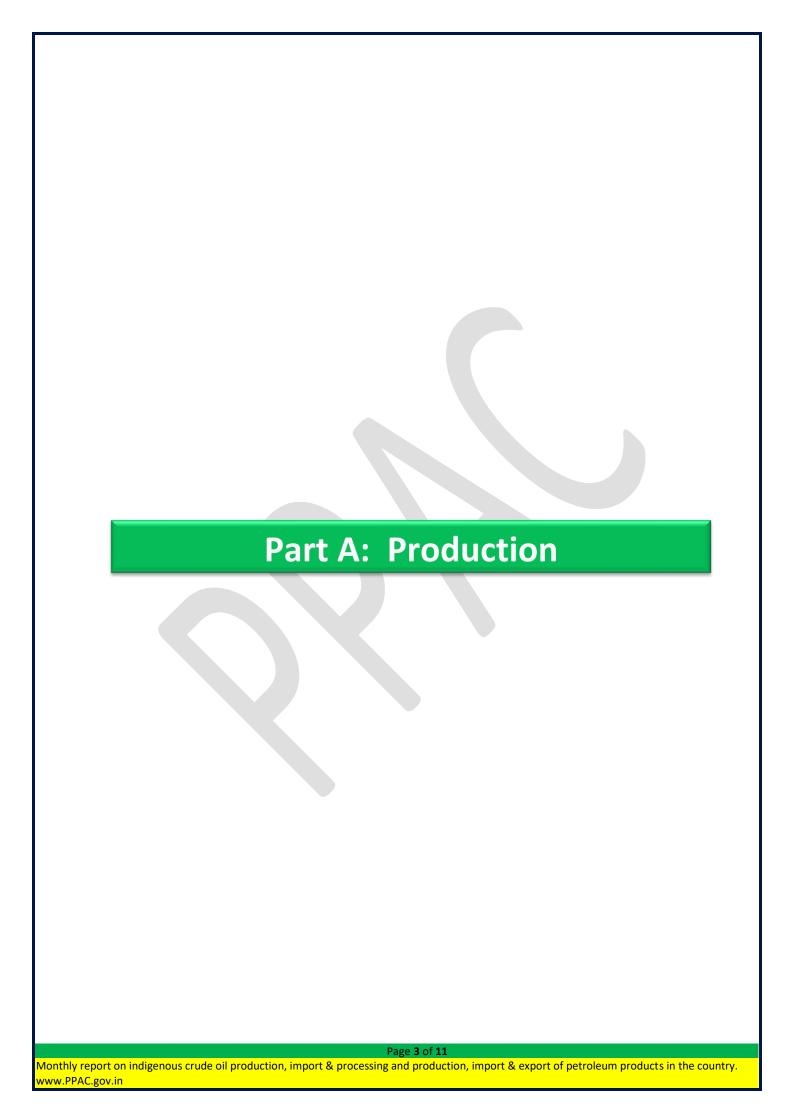

1. In this monthly report, indigenous crude oil production, imports and processing as well as production and imports/exports of petroleum products by oil companies are analyzed to assess the domestic availability of petroleum products in the country.

Highlights

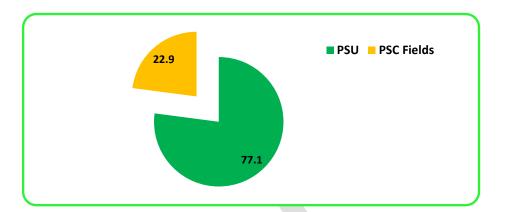
- Indigenous crude oil and condensate production during September 2024 was 2.3 MMT. OIL
 registered a production of 0.3 MMT, ONGC registered a production of 1.5 MMT whereas PSC/RSC
 registered production of 0.5 MMT during September 2024. There is a de-growth of 4% in crude
 oil and condensate production during September 2024 as compared with the corresponding
 period of the previous year.
- Total Crude oil processed during September 2024 was 21.3 MMT which is 4.4 % higher than September 2023, where PSU/JV refiners processed 14 MMT and private refiners processed 7.3 MMT of crude oil. Total indigenous crude oil processed was 2.1 MMT and total imported crude oil processed was 19.2 MMT by all Indian refineries (PSU+JV+PVT). However, there was a growth of 1.8 % in total crude oil processed in April-September FY 2024 25 as compared to same period of FY 2023 24.
- Production of petroleum products was 22.7 MMT during September 2024, which is 5.8 % higher than September 2023. Out of 22.7 MMT, 22.4 MMT was from refinery production & 0.3 MMT was from fractionator. Out of total POL production, in September 2024, share of major products including HSD is 39.4 %, MS 17 %, Naphtha 6.4 %, ATF 6.7 %, Pet Coke 5 %, LPG 4.4%, and rest is shared by Bitumen, FO/LSHS, LDO, Lubes & others.
- Crude oil imports increased by 6.0% and 3.9% during September 2024 and April-September FY
 2024-25 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- POL products imports increased by 2.9% and 10.3% during September 2024 and April-September
 FY 2024-25 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase
 in POL products imports during April-September FY 2024-25 were mainly due to an increase in
 imports of liquified petroleum gas (LPG), petcoke and lubes/LOBS etc.
- Exports of POL products increased by 34.9% and 3.3% during September 2024 and April-September
 FY 2024-25 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during April-September FY 2024-25 were mainly due to increase in exports of petcoke/CBFS, fuel (FO) and aviation turbine fuel (ATF) etc.

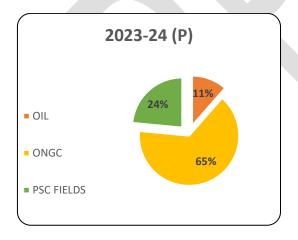

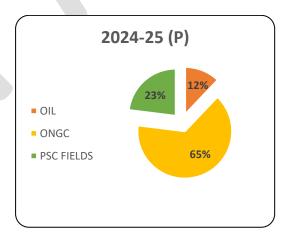
Figure-1; Percentage share in crude oil and condensate production; April-September FY 2024-25 (P)

Figure-2; Percentage share in crude oil production; April – September



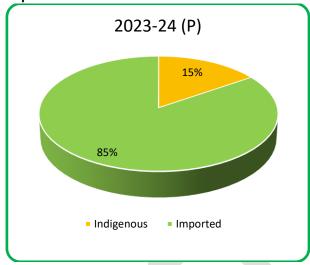

Figure-3; Percentage share of Indigenous/imported crude oil processed in PSU/JV refineries in April - September



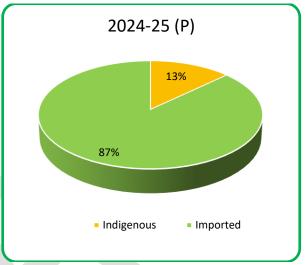
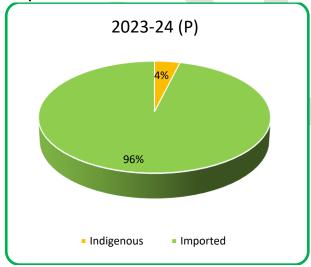
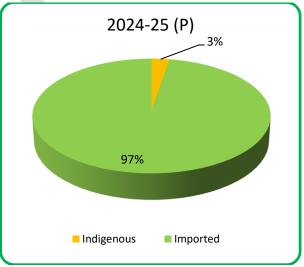


Figure-4; Percentage share of indigenous and imported crude oil processed by Private refineries: April - September

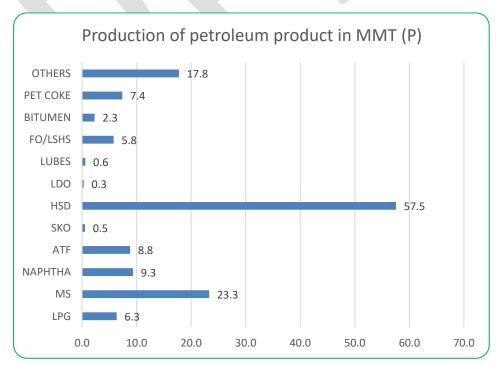

Figure-5; Product wise production of POL products by refineries and fractionators: April-September FY 2024-25 (P)

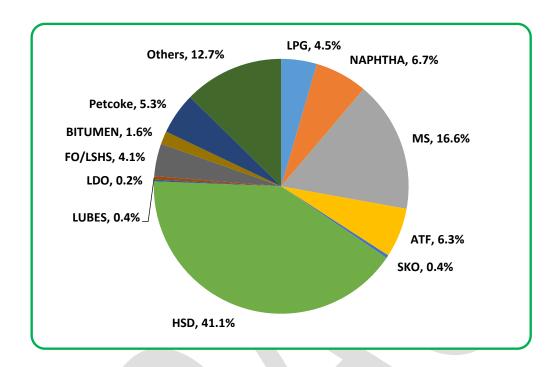

Figure-6; Percentage share of products in total POL production: April-September 2024-25 (P)





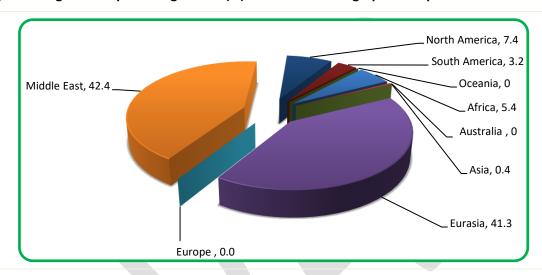

- Crude oil imports increased by 6.0% and 3.9% during September 2024 and April-September FY 2024-25 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- Crude oil imports from OPEC countries increased to 48.4% of total imports during April-September FY 2024-25 as compared to 47.2% during April-September FY 2023-24.

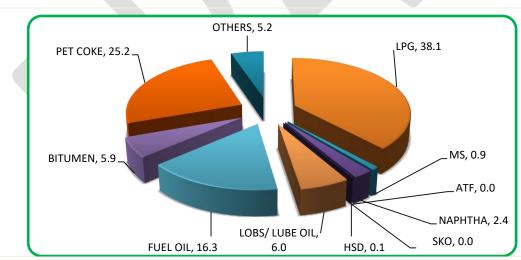


Figure 8: Percentage share of petroleum products in imports: April to September FY 2024-25 (P)

- Imports made due to a deficit in production viz. LPG and Lubes/LOBS accounted for 44.1% share of total POL products import during April-September FY 2024-25 as compared to 40.7% during April-September FY 2023-24.
- Imports of petcoke accounted for 25.2% of the total POL imports during April-September FY 2024-25. The entire quantity was imported by private importers.

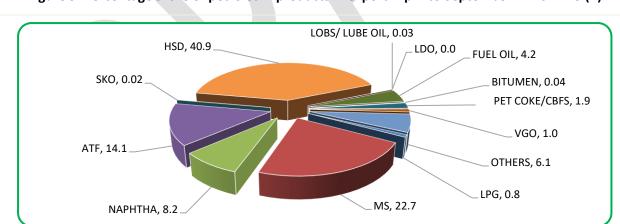


Figure 9: Percentage share of petroleum products in export: April to September FY 2024-25 (P)

Exports of POL products increased by 34.9% and 3.3% during September 2024 and April-September FY 2024-25 respectively as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Increase in POL products exports during April-September FY 2024-25 were mainly due to increase in exports of petcoke/CBFS, fuel (FO) and aviation turbine fuel (ATF) etc.
