- (iv) All eligible candidates shall be called for in person interview.

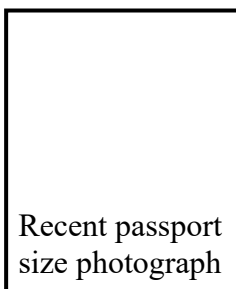
